
Your graduation day check list:

- 1. Arrival. Please arrive in plenty of time. It is recommended you arrive at The Guildhall (Market Square, Cambridge CB2 3QJ) 2½ hours before your ceremony. Please enter via the Peas Hill entrance. For information about travel and parking in Cambridge, please visit the Cambridge 'On the day' page on aru.ac.uk/graduation.
- 2. Check-In. Please check-in and collect your seating card and any guest tickets purchased. The check-in desks will be located within The Guildhall and staff will be on hand to direct you. Please bring your confirmation from eVision to exchange for your pre-purchased guest tickets.
- 3. Academic Dress. Please collect your pre-ordered academic dress (gown, hood and mortar board) from Graduation Attire, who will be located within The Guildhall. Please remember to bring your gown hire receipt/booking confirmation. Information about gown hire can be found via aru.ac.uk/graduation and by clicking on 'Gown Hire'.
- 4. Photography. If you wish to have your photograph taken in your academic dress, H. Tempest Limited, our official photographers, will be located within The Guildhall. Prebooking is not necessary, but please note check-in, robing and photography will close 1 hour before your ceremony start time. You will not be permitted to re-enter the Guildhall for photography after your ceremony. If you do not have your official photography taken before the ceremony you will have another opportunity to have photographs taken in a studio, in room: LAB 027, on the East Road central campus. Please note that large group/family photographs cannot be accommodated on campus. - 5. Take your Seat. Please be seated in the Cambridge Corn Exchange at least 30 minutes before your ceremony start time. The Cambridge Corn Exchange doors will be opened one hour before each ceremony and proceedings will begin promptly. For information on the location of the Cambridge Corn Exchange, please see overleaf. Once you enter the Cambridge Corn Exchange, you will be directed to your seat by an Anglia Ruskin University usher. Your seat is allocated to you and is indicated on your seating card,

- so please ensure you have your seating card with you. You will be seated in the order you will be called across the stage, so it is important to sit in your allocated seat.
- 6. Guests. Any guests accompanying you will be seated separately, therefore please ensure they have their tickets with them. Guest seating is not pre-allocated. If any of your guests have special seating requirements, of which we have already been notified, please ask them to report to an Anglia Ruskin University usher 1 ½ hours before the start of the ceremony. They will then be shown to their seat, which will be reserved under your name and based on requirements. Please note they may not be at the front.
- **7. Enjoy the Ceremony.** Celebrate your hard work and that of your fellow graduands.
- 8. Post-Ceremony Drinks Reception. Please join us for a celebratory drink at the post-ceremony drinks reception in the marquee in the LAB Courtyard, on the East Road central campus. You will find a walking map overleaf.
- 9. Merchandise. Stands offering a variety of merchandise to commemorate your special day will be found on the ground floor of the Science Centre on the East Road central campus. For a list of items available please visit aru.ac.uk/graduation-and-alumni/your-graduationceremony/memorabilia
- 10. Academic Dress Return. Please return your academic dress after your ceremony. Unless you have made special arrangements, all items of academic dress should be returned to Graduation Attire, representatives located on the ground floor of the Science Centre on the East Road central campus and highlighted overleaf.
