## Do you need support with your English language?

If English is not your first language, we can help.

**ELF (English Language Fix)** is a **free** service from the ARU Language Centre to support you while you study

#### Who can access it?

ELF is **free** and available to all UG,PG and research students. If English is not your first language, we are here to guide you and give you confidence.

We can help if you would like to improve your Academic English in general or if you have specific problems.

### How can we help?

Adjusting to life in a UK university can be challenging even if your English is at a good standard overall.

We can help you understand more about Academic English, approach assignments effectively, develop a successful academic presentation, improve a written assignment or work on any other assessment that you need support to complete.

We can also give general advice on how to get the most out of your lectures, improve your participation in seminars and communicate better with tutors and fellow students.

### What kind of support is available?

We offer **online and face-to-face lessons** which you can join regularly or for specific sessions. These lessons and materials cover the following areas:

- Writing and reading (including support for assignments/dissertations, academic style, analysing assignment tasks, reading extensively, formatting and referencing)
- Language support (including typical grammatical errors, academic vocabulary, complex grammar, passive voice for academic context, use of tenses and articles)
- **Speaking and listening** (including note taking in lectures, language for academic presentations, pronunciation focus)

There is a one-hour lesson per week for each of the three topic areas. You can do all three (a maximum of three hours per week) or choose specific areas or lessons.

You can choose the face-to-face option or attend online.

We also have a Canvas site with lots of materials and **self-study work** that you can access to improve your use of English

### **Group classes**
