Working with academic staff, you specify an activity, project, task or competition based on your needs and expectations, which will form part of our undergraduate students' compulsory learning. It results in agreed deliverables that students present to you.

A Live Brief is a short-term collaboration typically lasting one term where students are supported on

campus by an academic whilst you provide guidance and feedback from a professional, industry specific perspective. They benefit from increased confidence and employability skills, whilst your business gets access to original thinking, and extra capacity for short-term projects.




